### Biography

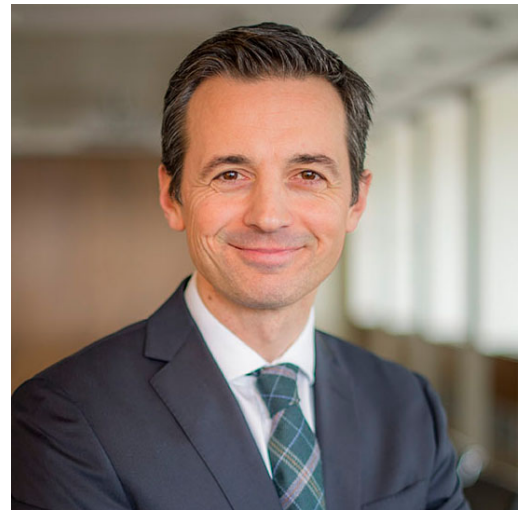
